



Shelter from the Storm Ministries is a Transitional Living Program for homeless single mothers and their minor children. They offer residents a safe, stable environment where they can take a breath and regain confidence to grow and thrive.

Residents are welcomed into our program for six to twelve months, depending on their individual needs. They offer an ongoing aftercare program to support women as they move out of our homes and on to the next season of their lives.

As of December 31st, 2023, the Shelter from the Storm Ministries provided 58,163 safe and warm bed nights to women and their children. They have served 81 Families and 188 children. They will be flipping a number of suites in June and are in need of new items to replace the items that will be given to families moving out. They are also in need of many on-going items.

New items need to stock suites when families move out:

- ❖ Kitchen
 - small appliances like crockpots, coffee makers
 - service ware, like plates, bowls, glasses, utensils
 - cooking utensils
 - towels

- ❖ Bathroom
 - towels and rags
 - bath mats

- ❖ Bedroom
 - sheets and blankets (for full sized)
 - clothes hampers
 - under the bed storage bins

Ongoing items always needed:

- ❖ For paper and other goods
 - toilet paper
 - paper towels
 - Kleenex
 - kitchen drawstring scented trash bags (13 gal)
 - bathroom scented trash bags
 - paper plates
 - forks/spoons/knives- plastic ware
 - tide pods detergent
 - bounce fabric sheets
